

# INFO SHEET



## **PURPOSE**

The purpose of City Week is to reach the community around us by showing the love of Jesus to all that we come in contact with. We will be present in downtown Brooksville and will have the opportunity to serve the community in multiple ways.

## **MINISTRY**

We will be ministering in several ways throughout City Week...street ministry, drama, music, feeding the hungry, ministry/service projects (Joseph's House), witnessing, etc. Come prepared to WORK! Mainly, come with a heart to serve and an expectancy to see God move in the lives of people.

## **AGE REQUIREMENT**

Students must be going into 8<sup>th</sup> grade by the Summer 2019. Any students in 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> grades will be allowed to participate if parent volunteers for City Week Outreach.

## **WHAT TO BRING**

Have enough clothing for 1 week, bedding (sheets/sleeping bag – we will be staying at Lakewood Retreat), socks, undergarments, GOOD WALKING SHOES, toiletries, flashlight, vitamins, sunscreen, bug repellent, notebook, Bible and a heart willing to serve!

## **WEATHER AND CLOTHING**

We live in a very warm climate and June comes with no exceptions! We will be giving each member of the City Week team 2 t-shirts and we are asking that they be worn during the day for the outreaches that we will be doing. Since we will be on our feet and doing a lot of walking, it is vital that you have comfortable shoes.

## **HOUSING**

We will be staying at Lakewood Retreat (25458 Dan Brown Hill Rd. Brooksville, FL 34602). We will be staying the nights of Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday at Lakewood Retreat. Accommodations are limited to the first 40 students.

## **WHEN TO ARRIVE**

Arrival is set for Tuesday, June 11<sup>th</sup> at Lakewood Retreat. Check in is from 5-6pm with a MANDATORY ORIENTATION at 6pm. Meals will be provided beginning Tuesday evening all the way thru Friday night.

## **COST**

The cost per person for this entire week is only \$100!!! This covers everything! Food, transportation around for the week, t-shirts, lodging, etc. We have been able to make it this cheap because of the generosity of several people within the church who have a heart to see this community touched, impacted, and healed for Jesus!

## **APPLICATIONS**

Registration applications are due by Wednesday, May 1<sup>st</sup> along with a non-refundable \$50 deposit. The remaining \$50 will be due by Wednesday, May 29<sup>th</sup>. All forms are required to be filled out completely and for students under the age of 18 a parent/guardian signature is required on their Release Form.

## **LEADERS AND VOLUNTEERS**

To effectively pull-off this event **WE NEED LEADERS AND VOLUNTEERS!!!** To be a leader/volunteer for City Week you must be at least 19-years-old. There is **NO COST** for leaders and volunteers! We know that in being a volunteer for this week it more than likely means that you are taking time off of work to help make this happen...and that is a blessing to us...so we would like to be a blessing to you! Breakfast and Lunch is provided for leaders and volunteers but dinner is the responsibility of the leader/volunteer. Also, only students and a select few leaders will be staying at Lakewood Retreat. Most leaders/volunteers will be staying at their own residence and meeting us each morning at the church. All leaders/volunteers are required to fill out the leader/volunteer registration application. Leaders/volunteers are responsible for their own transportation to and from all activities happening throughout City Week.
